**NCGA Points:** 150 pts – 1<sup>st</sup> 100 pts – 2<sup>nd</sup> 60 pts – 3<sup>rd</sup> 45 pts – 4<sup>th</sup> 30 pts – 5<sup>th</sup> 15 pts – 6-10<sup>th</sup> & ties

**Online Registration:** [www.sacgolfcouncil.org](http://www.sacgolfcouncil.org) for online registration option. (Please note \$10.00 administrative charge for any withdrawal for on-line registrations).

**Eligibility:** Open to all male amateur golfers with a current **USGA Index of 3.9 or less.**

**Entry Fees:** \$141.00 per person - For two (2) days green fees (\$80.00), administrative costs and awards – power cart not included. **Deadline for entry is July 1, 2009, no refunds after the closing date.** Cancellations and requests for refunds prior to the closing date should call Joe Dahilig, Director at 916 359 1933. **Do not call the golf course.** Your signed entry form indicates willingness by the rules and decisions of the Tournament Committee. There will be a \$20.00 service charge on all returned checks. Field is limited to paid entries from the first 128 players. Carts may be reserved by calling the Golf Shop at (916) 482-3284. **(See Carts below)**

**Format:** **Stroke Play over 36-holes.** 18-holes on Saturday and Sunday July 11 and 12. In the event of tie(s) for the Championship, a sudden-death playoff at completion of play on Sunday, July 12 will determine champion. All other ties will be determined by matching cards (Low Score: Last 9 holes, 6 holes, 3 holes 18<sup>th</sup>, etc).

**Awards:** The player with the 36-hole low gross score will be the **2009 SACRAMENTO COUNTY MEN’S AMATEUR CHAMPION** and will earn 150 NCGA Player Points. The Champion will have his name inscribed on the Tournament’s perpetual trophy, receive an individual championship trophy and merchandise card redeemable at Ancil Hoffman pro shop. Other winners will receive merchandise cards. Presentation of awards will take place immediately following the conclusion of tournament on Sunday. Certificates for winners not present will be mailed.

**Rules:** Governed by the USGA Rules of Golf, its decisions and Local Rules posted by the Committee prior to play. The Tournament Committee will rule on all Rules Questions. **Pace of Play Policy will be enforced.** The use of cellular phones or pagers during the event is discouraged or to the off position. **Distance only devices are allowed.**

**Carts:** Cost not included in the entry fee. Course Policy: \$30.00 per cart for one rider. Sharing, \$15.00 each.

**DRESS CODE:** Shirts with sleeves and collars – shorts should be hemmed just above the knee or slacks – jeans are discouraged. **Please no metal penetrating golf shoe spikes.**

**Times:** Competitors are responsible for obtaining their tee times and checking in at a registration table at least 20 minutes prior to their starting time. Tee times are available at Ancil Hoffman GC, 482-3284 by Monday July 6, 2009, [www.sacgolfcouncil.org](http://www.sacgolfcouncil.org) or e-mailed (for those with e-mail addresses)

**Qualifier:** This Stroke Play Championship is one of 3 qualifying sites for the **State Fair Championship (Sep 5-6-7, 2009)** at MacKenzie GC. A maximum of **20 paid qualifiers out of the top 40 will earn a spot** in the State Fair Championship. Qualifiers add \$25.00 with this entry form or enter at tournament site. **Qualifiers may deduct \$25.00 from the SFC entry.** For additional SFC info go to [www.statefairgolf.net](http://www.statefairgolf.net). **Qualifiers must submit an entry for the SFC within two weeks after qualifying.** Tournament scores are posted at [www.sacgolfcouncil.org](http://www.sacgolfcouncil.org). Qualifying try only once: Sacramento County, City or Masters Tournaments.
