California State Fair Junior Championship
Saturday, August 29, 2009

Eligibility: This tournament is open to all junior golfers between the age 12 and 17 as of August 29, 2009.

Entry Fees: \$50.00 per person – Age 12 to 17; \$25.00 per person – Age 11 and under. Includes entry fee, green fees, lunch and awards. No refunds. Field is limited to paid entries from the first 144 players. **ENTRIES POSTMARKED PRIOR TO JULY 15, 2009 WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.** This tournament fills quickly and entries should be submitted at the earliest acceptable date. Deadline for entry is 5:00 p.m. August 21, 2009. Submission of an entry indicates willingness on the part of the player to abide by the rules and decisions of the Tournament Committee. There will be a \$20.00 service charge on all returned checks.

Format: Players age 12 to 17 will play 18 holes of metal play on the Alister McKenzie Golf Course and players age 11 and under will play 9 holes medal play on the Arcade Creek Golf Course. Flights are established by age group for boys and girls. Ties for the boys and girls champion will be played off, as will first place in each age group. All other ties will be broken in accordance to USGA Rule 33-6/2.

Awards: Boys and Girls Low Gross over the field will have their names placed on the perpetual trophy. Awards will be presented to the low gross scorers in each age group. Presentation of awards will take place immediately following the conclusion of the tournament. All winners are requested to be present to accept their awards. Final results will be posted on the SGC website.

Rules: All play will follow United States Golf Association (USGA) Rules, except for Local Rules posted by the Tournament Committee prior to play. In the absence of a Rules Official, the competitors shall refer any disputes to the Tournament Committee, whose decision shall be final. All players must abide by the JGANC rules. If at any point a dispute is not covered by USGA or Local Rules, the decision shall be made in accordance with equity. Players are responsible for returning their own attested and correct scorecard. **Caddies are NOT permitted. NO CELL PHONES OR CAMERAS ARE PERMITTED DURING PLAY.**

UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT – The use of abusive language, throwing of golf clubs, or other disruptive behavior will not be allowed—PENALTY: DISQUALIFICATION.

Recommended dress code: Appropriate golf attire – shirts with sleeves—shorts should be hemmed just above the knee, or slacks—denim clothing is discouraged. Metal, penetrating golf shoe spikes are prohibited.

Starting Times/

Check-in: **Players age 12 to 17 must check in by 7:30AM for a prompt 8AM shotgun start. Players age 11 and under must check in at least 30 minutes prior to their starting time. Tee times for age 11 and under will be posted at the golf shop, and will also be posted on the Council website at www.sacgolfcouncil.org one week before the day of play.**
