Eligibility: Open to all male amateur golfers, age 35-54 by September 5, 2009, who are members of an organized golf club with a current GHIN Index of 5.4 or less.

The August GHIN will be used to determine eligibility unless confirmation of equivalent ability is received.

**Confirmation of equivalent ability may be submitted in lieu of a GHIN to establish eligibility. Please contact Sean Wong, Tournament Director, for any eligibility questions.*

Entry Fees: \$155 per player. Includes Saturday & Sunday green fess, and Monday green fees for players making the cut, range balls and awards—power carts not included.

Deadline for mail-in entry is August 27, 2009, with no refunds after August 27, 2009. Online entry deadline is Saturday, August 29, 2009. Late entries will be taken subject to approval by the Tournament Director. There will be a \$20 service charge for all returned checks. Online Registration Please visit www.sacgolfcouncil.org for the online registration/payment option or mail this entry with a check. Online and mail-in entry fee options are each \$155.

Format: **Stroke Play.** The Contestants will play 18 holes on Saturday, September 5, 2009 and 18 holes on Sunday, September 6, 2009 at the Bing Maloney Golf Course. The top 33% of the field and ties will make the cut and play a final round on Monday, September 7, 2008. The contestant with the lowest score for the 54-holes will be declared the **2009 California State Fair Masters Champion**. In the event of a tie for the Championship, a sudden death victory playoff will start immediately following play beginning on the 17th tee.

Awards: The Champions name will be inscribed on the perpetual trophy and he will receive a merchandise gift card. All other players making the cut will also receive gift cards.

Rules: Play will be governed by the current USGA Rules of Golf, its Decisions and the conditions listed on the Notice to Competitors. Cart usage is permitted during the tournament at such player's expense. Local Rules, Notice to Competitors, pace of play policy, and hole location charts will be available at registration. Contestants are responsible for reporting to the first tee 10 minutes before their tee time. The note under Rule 6-3 is in effect. The use of caddies is permitted in accordance with Rule 6-4 and the use of distance measuring devices is permitted as long as the device measures **distance only**.

Mandatory Tournament Dress Code: Collared golf shirts with sleeves, shorts should be hemmed just above the knee, golf slacks (no jeans allowed). Bing Maloney Golf Course prohibits the use of metal spikes.

Times: Contestants should check in at the registration area at least 20 minutes prior to their scheduled start time. Starting times will be posted in the golf shop and emailed to the players providing an email address by September 2, 2009.
