**Registration:** [www.sacgolfcouncil.org](http://www.sacgolfcouncil.org) - Online registration or mail entry with fee.

**Entry Fees:** **\$140.00 - Entry fee includes green fees for the three days (if cut is made),** Entry also includes administrative cost, Junior Golf Support and awards. **Entry does not include golf cart. Entries close on Friday August 28, 2009. No refunds after this date.** Those seeking refunds prior to August 21st should contact Dewey Sutton, Tournament Director at (916) 987-1449. **Do not call the golf shop for refunds!** Field is limited to the first 144 players. Submission of an entry form indicates willingness on the part of the player to abide by the rules and decisions of the Tournament Committee. There will be a \$20.00 service charge on all returned checks.

**Eligibility:** This tournament is open to amateur golfers age 18 and older, who are members of an organized golf club with a current 2009 handicap between 5 and 20. In Accordance With the USGA rule 33-1 and 10-3/E the SGC has the authority to adjust a handicap based on tournament scores. Entries that exceed the maximum 20 strokes, must agree to play at the 20 maximum handicap allowed.

**Format:** 54 holes of stroke play over a three-day period. The field will be divided into flights commensurate with total entry. The field will be reduced by approximately 50% after day two. Those making the 36-hole cut play 18 holes on the final day,

**Ties:** All ties are broken according to the USGA Recommended Rule 33-6, matching scorecards. Exception: Ties for the low net score for the tournament will be broken by a sudden death play-off with appropriate handicaps to determine the winner and be the CALIFORNIA STATE FAIR NET CHAMPION.

**Awards:** The player with the total low net score over the field will be declared the 2009 California State Fair net Champion and his name will be inscribed on the perpetual trophy and awarded a gift certificate. Other prizes will be awarded based on net scores in each flight. Presentation will take place directly following the completion of the tournament. All winners are required to be present to accept their awards.

**Rules:** All play will follow United States Golf Association (USGA) Rules, Local Rules of the course, and other rules posted by the Tournament Committee prior to play. Tournament Committee decisions will be final. Decisions not covered by USGA or Local Rules, will be made in accordance with equity. Players are responsible for signing and returning their signed attested scorecards to the scoring table immediately following each round. Use of cell phones will be prohibited during play.

**Carts:** **AHGC cart policy: \$30.00 per cart. Two (2) carts per foursome. Cost can be shared by riders**

**Misc:** **Recommended dress code:** shirts with sleeves and collars – shorts should be hemmed just above the knee or slacks. Participants will be paired within their respective flights.

**Starting Times/**

**Check-in:** All rounds will start when scheduled. Contestants must check in at the tournament registration table at least 30 minutes prior to their starting time. Tee times will be posted on the **SGC website [www.sacgolfcouncil.org](http://www.sacgolfcouncil.org)** and available at Ancil Hoffman GC 916 482 3284 one week prior to the tournament. Carts are also available at that number.
